The guiding principle of this code of conduct is to treat others as you would like yourself to be treated.

- a. Treat everyone with respect, courtesy and fairness
- b. Behave ethically, fairly, courteously and honestly in all dealings with other people and organisations
- c. Comply with the rules and spirit of netball including the Briars Netball Club, Inner West Netball Association and Netball Australia guidelines
- d. Act with care and diligence when representing BNC
- e. Be aware of Netball New South Wales Codes of Behaviour Policy and promote compliance with the policy
- f. Be aware of the Play by the Rules framework and understand the possible consequences of breaching that framework

- g. Report any misconduct or breaches of the Play by the Rules framework to the appropriate person(s) within the club as appropriate
- h. Raise any concerns in regards to decisions or conduct of players, coaches, managers, umpires or committee members through the appropriate channels and in a timely manner
- i. Refrain from any form of abuse, harassment, discrimination and/or victimisation
